# Eligibility

- Must not have been an EBFA awardee during the 2021 calendar year
- **Organization** located in the East Bay commissioning a Bay Area artist **OR**
- Artist living in the East Bay, a fiscal sponsor is required (does not have to be in the Bay Area)
- Commission must support a new work

# **Organization or Artist Application**

- Should I apply as an individual artist or as an organization?
- A few questions to help you answer this question:
  - Who is truly leading the work?
  - Who is commissioning the project?
  - Whose audience or base is being expanded?

# East Bay Fund for Artists **What the panel will be looking for:**

- Creation of **new work** and support of individual artists:
  - Clear vision with strong artistic practice.
  - EBFA Funds and request must be allocated to the **lead artist(s)** (\$5,000 up to \$25,000).
- Engagement with community/audience.
- Social justice themes in work.



# Sample Budget

Income		Expenses	
EBFA	\$500	Michael Jackson (lead artist)	\$500
Individual donors	\$500	Janet Jackson (supporting artist)	\$200
In-Kind	\$50	Recording studio fee	\$200
Foundation	\$100	Premiere venue fee	\$200
Government	\$150	Fiscal sponsor fee	\$50

#### How the Panel Will Score Applications

- Clear articulation of the project and how it aligns with the artist's artistic practice/creative development.
- Demonstrated ability to complete project.
- Plan to reach/engage your audience.
- Strength of social justice themes & issues.
- Organizations:
  - Rationale for selecting the artist(s)
  - Ability to manage the project

# Work Sample

- 1 or 2 work samples per lead artist
- Audio or Video:
  - .mp4 or .mov
  - No more than 3 minutes long
  - Upload to Youtube or Vimeo
- Photos one caption and photo per slide on a PPT
- Upload work sample via Survey Monkey





## Timeline

- **Deadline to apply:** October 3, 2022
- **Panel Decision:** Early November, 2022
- Grants Disbursed: Late November, 2022
- East Bay Premiere: within 1 year of receipt of award



# **Fiscal Sponsorship**

- A fiscal sponsor is required for all artists and organizations who do not have their own 501c3.
  - Does not need to be located in the East Bay.
- Fiscal Sponsor Organizations:

- Many local nonprofits provide sponsorship to a smaller number of projects. If you've worked closely with a nonprofit organization in the past, ask if they have sponsorship opportunities.
